UNAUTHORIZED BOARDING

Ref: UKMTO ADVISORY 040-25 – ILLEGAL BOARDING

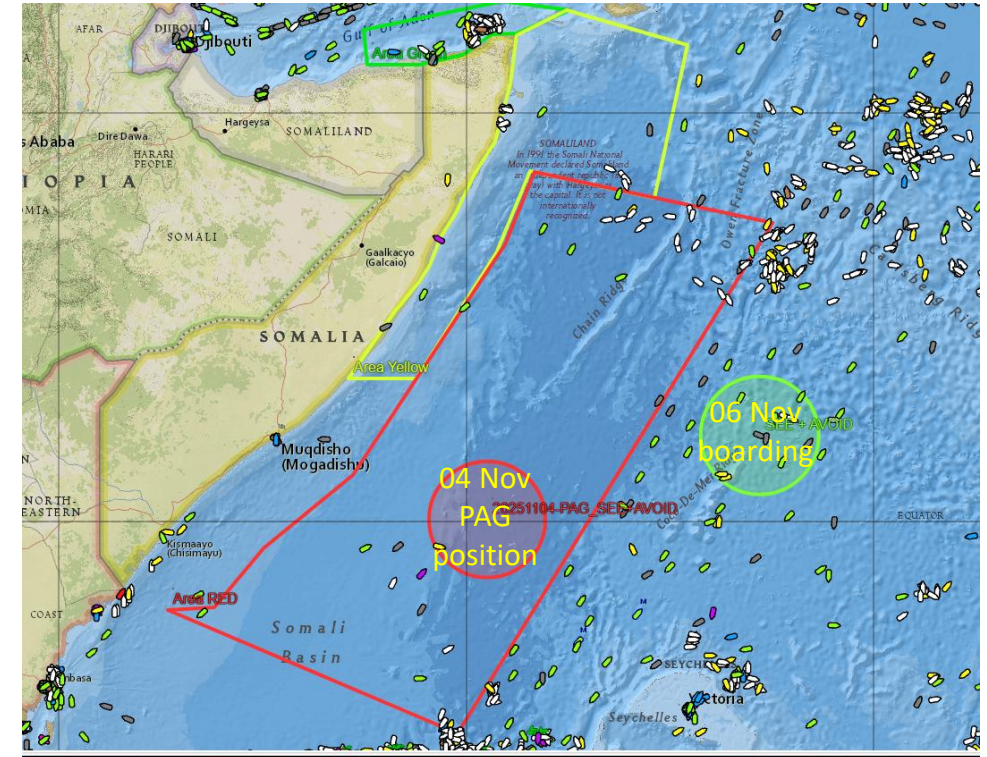


Figure 1 (Source: UKMTO)

UKMTO has published multiple warnings of unauthorized boarding attempts in the southern portion of the area denoted in figure 1 over the period of 28 October to 03 November 2025. A boarding reported 06 November, 560 NM from the coast of Somalia, is linked to the same pirate action group (PAG). This unauthorized boarding represents the easternmost incident of piracy since the end of the seasonal monsoon.

Current situation:

There are increased levels of small boat and mother ship activity in the area east of Somalia to include a confirmed PAG.

JMIC will update this advisory as the situation develops.

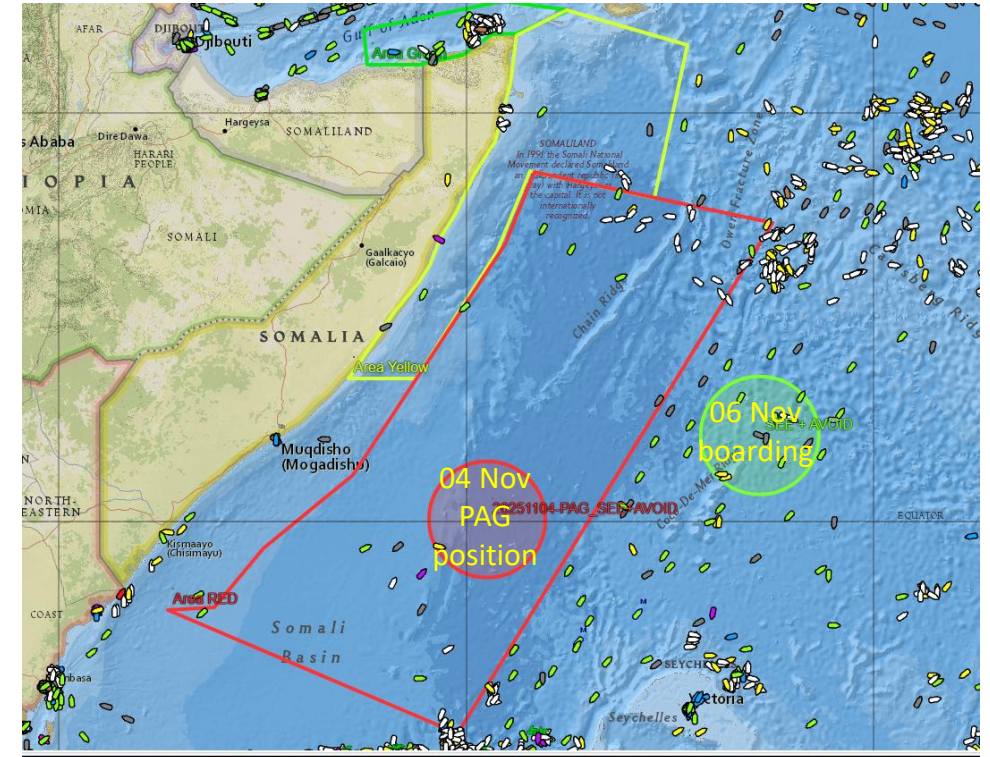
JMIC RECOMMENDATIONS
